Meals will be provided free of charge in the French Camp Academy Dining Hall at the regular school lunch times (Monday through Friday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m.) for all enrolled students at **French Camp Academy** regardless of race, color, national origin, sex, age or disability, with no discrimination in the course of the meal service. Students having already paid for meals either through resident tuition or a meal plan for the months of August through May, will receive a credit towards their account.
